To Whom It May Concern

Our staff is engaged in providing Home Healthcare Services for clients that have been referred to us by their Primary Healthcare Physician (PHCP) and who are medically sensitive to their residential indoor environment.

It has been well documented by the EPA, American Industrial Hygiene Association (AIHA); American Conference of Industrial Hygienists (ACGIH) and other organizations that biological contaminants such as mold and bacteria in the indoor environment can result in upper respiratory problems, hypersensitivity pneumonitis, acute idiopathic pulmonary hemorrhage among infants, or early onset of asthma in youth. This is an even greater risk with patients that are medically sensitive. This is now exacerbated by the 'shelter-in-place' recommendations and orders, these patients are now confined to the indoor environment throughout each day.

The concern of our clients and their PHCP is whether it is safe to work or occupy their residence or property or not. We are engaged in sampling services followed by laboratory analysis of those samples to make that determination.

We have addressed the health and safety issues for both our client and workers. Our staff will be wearing appropriate personal protective equipment. We have called our clients ahead of time to ensure that they are not currently exhibiting any symptoms of concern.

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Please review the following statements from each County regarding Construction Exemptions through the Shelter-in-Place submitted by the Health Orders:

- Marin County – “Plumbers, electricians, exterminators, and other **service providers who provide services that are necessary to maintaining the safety, sanitation, and essential operation of residences**, Essential Activities, and Essential Businesses;”
- San Francisco County – “The Order also allows new residential construction projects if they are adding to the supply of affordable housing that is or will be income-restricted, including creating at least 10% income-restricted units, or **maintaining the habitability of homes to avoid displacement of residents**,”
- Contra Costa County – “Construction or repair necessary to ensure that **a residence or a building containing essential businesses is safe, sanitary, and habitable** if that work cannot be reasonably delayed.”
- Santa Clara County – “Construction or repair necessary to ensure that **residences and buildings containing Essential Businesses are safe, sanitary, or habitable** to the extent such construction or repair cannot reasonably be delayed;”
- Sacramento County – “Plumbers, electricians, exterminators, and other **service providers who provide services that are necessary to maintaining the safety, sanitation, and essential operation of residences**, Essential Activities, and Essential Businesses;”
- Sonoma County – “Construction or repair necessary to ensure that **residences and buildings containing Essential Businesses are safe, sanitary, or habitable** to the extent such construction or repair cannot reasonably be delayed;”
